A MESSAGE FROM OUR BOARD

This message is coming from our entire Board of Directors because we consider the content so critical.

TIME IS RUNNING OUT! The future of our cemeteries has never been in greater jeopardy.

By vote of its membership, Congregation Shaarey Tefiloh is closing its doors and selling its building because the former Jewish Community that supported the synagogue has vanished. Although regular services are no longer

being conducted, a small group continues to daven in the lobby (to economize on operational costs), and the synagogue's leaders continue to light the Yahrzeit memorial lights.

Despite the vote for closure and the anticipated sale of the building, it remains the responsibility of Congregation Shaarey Tefiloh to care for its cemeteries forever. Like many other cemeteries nationwide owned by synagogues and fraternal lodges, the prices set for plots and perpetual care never approached what the true cost of cemetery maintenance would be --- even without considering the cost of expected and unexpected repairs. Congregation Shaarey Tefiloh is committed to providing for its cemeteries forever --- and your donations have never been more important toward achieving this goal.

It is unquestionably a challenging time to be selling any real estate, and it is also a difficult time for most people to be as charitable as they would like to be. It is also important for us to tell you that --despite our efforts and your generosity --- Friends for Preservation of Middlesex County Jewish

Cemeteries, Inc. has not raised even enough funds to pay for ongoing cemetery maintenance.

Thus, we are reaching out to you now to (1) thank you for your past support, (2) ask you to be as generous as you can be now, and (3) consider making a major donation if you can afford to do so. Those of us with roots in the Perth Amboy Jewish Community are aging and declining in numbers. Many of our original supporters are no longer alive, and we face the reality that none of us will be here forever to carry on this mission.

If you have donated before, we thank you and hope you will donate again, being as generous as you can afford to be. If you haven't donated before, this will be a wonderful time to send a donation to honor the memory of those interred in our cemeteries. 


FLORIDA REUNION BREAKFAST

After serving the Orthodox Jewish community of Perth Amboy for 108 years, Congregation Shaarey Tefiloh is closing its doors forever and hopefully will be selling its building soon. Most of its treasured contents will be sold at a special sale, which will be held at the synagogue on **Sunday, October 23 at 10:00 am.**



Most furniture and items structurally attached to the building (e.g., stained glass windows) will remain to be sold with the building. A permanent home for the bronze memorial tablets is planned. The disposition of all items will follow Orthodox Halacha.
