# President's Message

Eleven years have passed since we formed this organization, and our mission

has grown considerably since then. Although we have accomplished a lot, much work remains to be done.

Our primary goal continues to be raising funds for our cemeteries — all of which hold our heritage and our history — and all of which cost much more to preserve than our founding ancestors ever imagined. As we continue working toward this primary goal, though, we have expanded our mission to honor our ancestors in many other ways too.

We have helped many people explore their ancestry — not only locating and translating monuments, but also educating people about their roots and our community history. We are especially glad

to help members of the younger generations learn about their individual genealogy, so that they can develop an interest and learn while many of their ancestors are still alive. Most of us become interested in genealogy as we age regrettably after most of our ancestors are no longer here to answer our questions. It is refreshing and inspiring to see some of our children and grandchildren at our Cemetery Tours — already interested in genealogy while we are still here

leven years to answer their questions.

With this in mind, we have provided the information on Congregation Shaarey Tefiloh's cememonuments, memorial plaques, and Yahrzeit cards to JewishGen as part of its Jewish Online Worldwide Burial Registry (JOWBR) project. Adding this information to the JOWBR database will memorialize forever the names and Yahrzeit dates of our community ancestors in a way that will make this information available to future generations. Thanks very much to Carol Roberts, Marcia Weinstein Stern, Richard Stern, Miriam Katz Daitz Vogel, Norma Jacobson Messing, Barry Rosengarten, Daniel Chazin, Lillian Faffer, and Ada Green for their assistance in collecting these data and implementing this enormous project.

It is understandable that our

cemeteries are valued by genealogists important an source of historical information, and I remind all of you that regular cemetery maintenance is required — forever in order to preserve cemetery accessibility to visitors and legibility of monument inscriptions. Although all tours are free, advance registration is recommended so that we can notify you of any weather-related cancellations and can locate any family graves of special interest to you. If you can't visit in person, we will be glad to visit for you and will place stones on the graves for you too.

and in the future.




